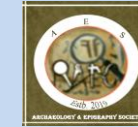

Dear Delegate, Greetings !

In continuation of the first circular sent by the Secretary, Archaeology & Epigraphy Congress, I take the privilege of inviting you to participate in the fourth session of Archaeology & Epigraphy Congress to be held on 17-18 December, 2022 at Department of History, Institute of Advanced Studies in Education (IASE), (Deemed to be University), Gandhi Vidya Mandir, Sardarshahar (Rajasthan) 331403.

About the Archaeology & Epigraphy Congress

Archaeology & Epigraphy Congress was established under the aegis of Archaeology & Epigraphy Society in 2019 to bring together scholars working in the field of archaeology, beginning from the period of the emergence of human beings in the region to 1947 A.D. It encompasses archaeology beneath the ground and above the surface.

Three sessions of the Congress have been successfully conducted so far. The first session was graciously organized by BJS Rampuria Jain College, Bikaner at the campus of Institute of Management Studies, Bikaner at which Prof. J.S. Kharakwal, Udaipur, well known Archaeologist, delivered his presidential address.

The second session which was organized by Gyan Vidhi P.G. Maha-vidyalaya, Bikaner, witnessed the presidential address delivered by well-known historian Dr. Girija Shankar Sharma. This session was attended by more than 100 delegates. The sessions were of great success and delegates presented their papers on PPT mode.

The latest third session was organized by SKD University, Hanumangarh, where more than 120 delegates participated. The highlight of this session was a visit by the delegates to Kalibanga, a famous archaeological site of the Indus Valley Civilization.

About the University

The Institute of Advanced Studies in Education (Deemed to be University) has a proud past stretching back to 1950 when the petite Gandhi Vidya Mandir, the parent Institution, was established in the desert land of Sardarshahar. The foundation stone of the Rural University was laid down by the first president of India Dr. Rajendra Prasad in 1955. The Institute of Advanced Studies in Education (Deemed to be University) (hereafter IASE) is an institution born out of the dedication of the founder Shri Kanhaiyalal Dugar (Later known as Swami Shri Ramsharan ji Maharaj). It emerged as a public university in 2002, when it got the formal recognition of Deemed to be University, under section 3 of the UGC Act 1956. It is duly accredited by NAAC as well. Today, the university is a vibrant centre of research and academics as it is rooted in a value-based education. Since its inception with a handful of students, the institution has slowly grown into a giant tree imparting education from primary to a post-doctoral level having three faculties, namely, Faculty of Education, Faculty of Engineering & Technology and Faculty of Humanities & Social Sciences. The sprawling 100 acres of the university campus is a verdant oasis in the lap of an intense desert. It is dotted by large parks, gardens, playgrounds, auditoria, cultural and spiritual centre.

About the Department

The Department of History was set up in 2012. It offers a rich range of courses in ancient, medieval and modern Indian, Rajasthan and World History dividing four semesters covering the duration of two years. Apart from offering the traditional courses, the Department has since long introduced themes like a historical tourism etc. The Department has acquired distinction for its emphasis on multiple components of historical knowledge-ideas, thought, and various branches of history. The department has long been proud of its extensive engagement with regional history (History of Rajasthan), a domain that has remained neglected till recent decades. To achieve the same the syllabi are reviewed and revised regularly with an eye on the NEP 2020 at all levels – M.A., and Ph.D. – equipped to succeed in the modern world.

About Sardarshahar

Sardarshahar is located in North western part of the Rajasthan state in the heart of Thar desert in Churu district. A tiny village named Rajiawas, in the erstwhile state of Bikaner, was picked up by His Highness Sir Ratan Singh to develop into a city after the name of his loving son Sardar Singh in 1838. The area was perhaps ruled by the Mohils of that time. A statue of Indrapal Mohil at the town side is a testimony to the fact. It is known for its grand havelis with beautiful frescoes work. Its white marble clock tower is remarkable for its unique architecture. The town is also famous for its architecture and wall painting. The town also has some religious places like Ram Manch, Ichchhapurna Balaji Temple, Samadhi Sthal-(Shanti Peeth) of Acharya Shri Mahapragya. It is the birthplace of Eleventh Acharya (Religious head)-Acharyashri Mahashramanji of Shri Jain Terapanthi Sect.
