Report of the Workshop

A national workshop was organized from 19 March to 21 March 29, 2023 at the Hall of FoE by the Faculty of Education, IASE Deemed to be University, Sardarshahr on: Continuous and Comprehensive Assessment in the Light of NEP 2020.

Inaugural Session on 19 March 2023 from 10.30 to 11.30

The session was chaired by Prof Pushpa Motiyani, Pro Vice Chancellor of the university and the chief guest of the session through online mode was Prof Marmar Mukhopadhyay, Educational Technology & Mgt Academy, Gurgaon. On the dais were Prof R.K.Sharma, Dean. Faculty of Education, Dr Vidushee Ameta, Dean, Faculty of Humanities and Social Science, Prof Manisha Verma, HoD and Dr P.K.Pandia, in charge, Department of Education. On this occasion Prof Pushpa Motiyani, Pro Vice Chancellor of the university said that Continuous and Comprehensive Assessment is the core concept to restructure an academic system. It is the foundation of any academic institute. She added that realizing the significance of assessment educationists have laid due stress on Continuous and Comprehensive Assessment in New Education Policy 2020 and that they have rightly devised various ways and means to ensure the proper assessment of the students for their holistic development.

Prof Marmar Mukhopadhyay, Educational Technology & Mgt Academy Gurgaon also expressed his views on the main theme of the workshop. Sharing his vast experience and knowledge he spoke on the practical aspects related to the assessment as envisaged in NEP 2020. He motivated the participants to sharpen their knowledge and insight to assess the students properly.

Dr P.K.Pandia introduced the participants with the workshop leading them to become familiar with the aims and objectives to be achieved through the workshop. Referring to the Hon'ble Vice chancellor Prof B.L. Sharma of IASE Deemed to be University, Sardarshahr as the mentor and brain behind the workshop, he expressed a sense of gratitude to him for motivation and mentorship, He also introduced the resource persons of the workshop.

Prof R.K.Sharma, Dean. Faculty of Education proposed the vote of thanks. He conveyed thanks to the management, Vice Chancellor, Registrar, and the faculty members of the Faculty of Education and Faculty of Humanities and Social Science including the supporting staff for successful organization of the workshop.

The session was attended by the participants both offline and online mode. The session was followed by a tea break.

First Day

First Technical session 19 March 2023 from 12 to 1.30 pm

Prof Marmar Mukhopadhyay, Educational Technology & Mgt Academy Gurgaon was the chief resource person who told the audience that keeping in view the need of hour NEP 2020 has incorporated the sound policy on Assessment to have the holistic picture of the all round development of the students. He spoke that assessment is the foundation of any educational system, that the practice of students' assessment has gone a long way over the years from oral testing to written test to public examination to internal and external assessment to continuous and comprehensive evaluation to competency-based (LO) assessment.

Second technical session on 19 March 2023 from 2 to 3 pm

Dr P.K.Pandia, in charge, Department of Education was the resource person. He had an interactive session deliberating the need and significance of the Continuous and Comprehensive Assessment in the Light of NEP 2020. Citing some practical examples drawn from the practical life of the life he underlined the importance of assessment in the practical life of every student. He said that NEP 2020 has aptly given due importance to Continuous and Comprehensive Assessment. The participants derived immense benefit out of this session. There was a doubt clearing session held to dispel the doubt of the participants. A

number of questions were asked which were replied by the resource person properly.

Dr P.K.Pandia, the resource person, was felicitated by Prof Pushpa Motiyani, pro vice chancellor of the university and Prof R,K,Sharma, Dean, Faculty of Education.

Second day (20 March 2023)

Third technical session on 20 March 2023 from 10.30 to 12 pm

The third technical session (Online) took place on 20 March 2023 which was taken up by Prof. Sunil Kumar Sain, Dept of Education, Guru Ghasidas Central University, Bilaspur (C G). At the very beginning he was introduced and welcomed. Prof Sunil addressed the audience and interacted with the participants on this occasion. He mentioned that some of the significant changes in student assessment that have made inroads so far into the system of academic institutes include the use of question paper formats (design, blue print etc.), use of various forms of questions (essay, long answer, short answer, very short answer, objective type), introduction of multiple choice questions, objective based question etc.

Fourth technical session on 20 March 2023 from 12 to 1.30 pm

The fourth technical session was taken up by Prof. Manisha Verma, through the PPT presentation. At the very beginning she was introduced and welcomed. She explained the concept of CCA. Prof Verma addressed the audience and interacted with the participants on this occasion, the participants. A number of questions were asked which were replied by the resource person properly.

Prof. Manisha Verma, the resource person, was felicitated at the end of the session.

Fifth technical session on 20 March 2023 from 2 pm to 3 pm

The **Fifth technical session** was taken up **by Prof. R.K.Sharma**, Dean, Faculty of Education. At the very beginning he was introduced to the participants. He explained the nuances of CCA. **Prof. R.K.Sharma**, addressed the audience and interacted with the participants on this occasion. He said that the question banks in different subjects, centralized spot evaluation, analysis of answer scripts for common errors and question papers, mechanical processing of examination results, supplementary examination and compartments examinations to improve grades, semester system, use of grades are the important areas of CCA.

Prof. R.K.Sharma, Dean, Faculty of Education., the resource person, was felicitated at the conclusion of the session by Dr P.K.Pandia, in charge, Department of Education.

Third day (21 March 2023)

Sixth technical session (Online) on 21 March 2023 from 12.30 pm to 2.00 pm

The third day and the **Sixth technical session** started on a positive note. The Sixth technical session was taken up by Prof. Sahab Ram, Principal. At the very beginning he was introduced to the M,D,College, Pallu. participants. Making use of the artificial intelligence he simplified the process of assessment in the academic world. He introduced the participants with the latest trends prevalent in the field of education. Explaining the basic concepts, process of the assessment and the nuances of CCA Prof. Sahab Ram, Principal M,D,College, Pallu had a very interactive session which enabled participants to enrich themselves with the CCA. He said that transparency in examination, providing photocopies of answer scripts on demand, weightage to internal assessment, continuous and comprehensive evaluation, learning 3 outcome (competency) based assessment, school-based assessment, steps taken in the management of examination etc. are steps towards the good assessment of students. He opined that outcomes of education depend a lot on the proper introduction of CCA. in educational institutes.

Valedictory Session

The dignitaries on the dais were: **Prof. R.K.Sharma**, Dean, Faculty of Education and Dr P.K.Pandia co-convener of the workshop. Dr P.K.Pandia presented the overall report of the workshop. Giving the details of the workshop he told the audience that there were 496 total registered participants out of them 296 participated the workshop offline whereas the rest joined it online.
