Feedback and Action Taken Report

Major Suggestions:

1. To add music as an optional subject in undergraduate course

Action Taken:

Music incorporated in the B.A.-B.Ed. syllabus as a core course for the students who are interested in taking 'music' as a student.

2. Students suggested implementing new specialization courses instead of Chetna Vikas Moolya Siksha every year.

3. Implementation of new certificate courses related to the practical realm

Action Taken:

After a lot of brainstorming, the Departmental Council and Board of Studies (BoS) passed five certificate courses to be initiated from the next academic year:

- a. Certificate Course in Medicinal Plant Cultivation
- b. Certificate Course in Bio-fertilizer Production and Management
- c. Certificate Course in Livestock Management and Dairy Production
- d. Certificate Course in Plant Propagation and Nursery Management
- e. Certificate Course in Yoga Training

4. Giving the credits for SWAYAM courses

Action Taken:

CBCS is incorporated in the M.Ed. Syllabus in which 4 credits are allotted for the SWAYAM courses related to the allied interdisciplinary area

5. The CR mentioned that 'Environmental Studies' as a paper is not incorporated in the syllabus of undergraduate program.

Action Taken:

The concerns of the students are presented in the Departmental Council and the members of BoS also suggested that as per UGC norms environmental education should be part of the undergraduate curriculum. It is identified that integrated undergraduate curriculum do not have



Environmental Studies as a compulsory paper. To resolve this issue the Environmental Studies as a compulsory paper added in the course content/syllabus.

6. Inter-disciplinary papers to be added for the students who are interested in subjects not in their allied course.

Action Taken:

In this contemporary world it is impossible to bottle up the interests of the students in a particular stream. The students demanded for interdisciplinary course. By days of brainstorming, it is concluded that the institute can offer few papers in M.Ed. course which will be open for all students of any discipline. Six papers were introduced as follows:
